INFORMATION FOR APPLICANTS

REMISSION OF TUITION FEES

Up to 37 Instrumental and Vocal Music Prizes will be offered to students entering Years 6 to 10 in 2020. Vocal prizes are not awarded to students in Years 6 to 8.

Music prizes provide 50 per cent of the cost of instrumental (orchestral or band instrument) or vocal tuition for 32 lessons and the free use of a College instrument, subject to availability. It is expected that all students with a Music Prize will enrol in Class Music, participate in a minimum of two co-curricular music ensembles and take advantage of performance opportunities at the College.

Students will not normally be awarded a music prize more than twice during their time at MLC.

AUDITION REQUIREMENTS

The attached form must be completed and returned to the Music Department, along with a copy of the audition pieces and accompaniment (if using a College accompanist). For the audition, candidates will be required to perform two contrasting pieces on their principal instrument. Candidates may additionally play one piece on their second instrument, if applicable. There will also be aural tests, sight reading and a short informal interview.

At the audition, candidates are required to provide a copy of the audition pieces for the adjudicator, a Music Portfolio of achievements (if applicable) and reference letter from present Instrumental or Vocal Music Teacher.

ACCOMPANIMENT

For accompanied pieces, candidates must provide their own accompanist or arrange a session with a College accompanist, through the Music Administrator, which will then be charged to student fee accounts. 2019 accompanist fees are \$23.50 per 15 minutes.

AUDITION DATES AND SCHEDULING

Music Prizes are offered on the results of audition, which is based on performance ability, general musicianship and musical potential. Auditions will take place from Monday 1 July to Thursday 4 July 2019 and audition times will be visible on Connect.S and Connect.P by Monday 24 June 2019. The audition will last approximately 15 minutes.
