



2018 RAFFLE FOR TUITION FEES

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

The MLC Foundation Tuition Fee Raffle is a fundraising activity organised by the MLC Foundation Inc. All proceeds (over and above the prize cost) go towards the MLC Building Fund for the purpose of the MLC Aquatic Centre Precinct development to benefit all MLC students.

The cost of each ticket is \$33.00.

Ticket sales will commence on Wednesday 15 August 2018 and close on Friday 19 October 2018 at midnight AWST.

Each family will be given the option to buy one ticket through a voluntary amount on their tuition fee account. Please note if this method of payment is chosen, MLC will need to receive the exact amount indicated as "Amount due including raffle" on the tuition fee invoice to guarantee inclusion in the raffle.

Families who pay their tuition fee account by direct debit and want to buy a ticket can opt in to the raffle by requesting the cost of one raffle ticket be charged to their tuition fee account. The request needs to be received via email by the Finance Department (accounts@mlc.wa.edu.au) by Monday 13 August 2018.

Any tuition fee accounts that are overdue on or after 28 September 2018 will not be included in the raffle.

- Select 'Donations and Tuition Fee Raffle'
- Open the first dropdown box select 'MLC Foundation Tuition Fee Raffle.'
- In the 'Donation Amount' category nominate in multiples of \$33.00 the number of tickets that you would like to purchase. For example, 1 ticket = \$33.00, 2 tickets = \$66.00, 3 tickets = \$99.00 or 10 tickets = \$330.00.

There is no limit to the number of tickets each entrant can buy, however the total number of raffle tickets is limited to 2,000.

Ticket sales are open to parents of a currently enrolled 2018 student, future parents who have confirmed their enrolment for 2018, relatives of a 2018 currently enrolled student and MLC community members (including staff, past parents, collegians and Council members) who may wish to nominate a family or gift at the Principal's discretion. Membership of any MLC association or association bodies, whether executive, or as a committee member, or otherwise, will not preclude participation in the raffle.

First prize is a credit of \$9,071.33, the equivalent of one third of the 2018 Year 12 tuition fee for a locally enrolled student.

The prize is only valid for a student attending MLC in 2018.

The prize will be allocated to the tuition fee account of the winning family and cannot be taken as a cash payment or in any other form.

Any unused portion of the prize is non-refundable.

If the winners so choose, the prize can be donated to the College as a contribution to the Foundation, and will be allocated to support the MLC Building Fund for the benefit of the MLC Aquatic Precinct development.

The prize will be drawn at the Years 7-9 Production Performance on 2 November 2018.

If the winner does not attend the event they will be notified by telephone or email, and a short story will be published in Wyvern on Friday 9 November with their name and image.

Any disputes or disagreements arising from the holding of the MLC Tuition Fee Raffle will ultimately be determined by the College. Once a decision has been made, no other correspondence will be entered into.
